

# How to book a visit at the Planetarium “Livio Gratton” in Latina (close to Rome, Italy)

The Planetarium “Livio Gratton” is open to foreign visitors organized in 20-people-at-least groups.

A lesson at the Planetarium takes 45 minutes, unless there are specific requests for longer and/or more specific performances.

A normal lesson costs €5,00/adult and €3,00/child (<11 year old).

The speaking language can be Italian or English on demand.

In order to book the first step is to send a FAX to the number of the Italian school Liceo Scientifico Statale “G.B.Grassi”:

addressed to Prof. Enzo Bonacci, where you specify which school/institute/association you are writing from.

Beyond your address, please write your fax and phone number and institutional email, otherwise your request will be rejected.

Another reason of rejection is the lack of signature on the fax; therefore please sign the document you will send us.

Once received the fax you will be re-contacted within a week, hence please send the request at least one month before the period you would like to come to Latina’s Planetarium.
